The Social Emotional Learning elements of Wigglebug are included in the activities your child can do with Wigglebug. Free Play and Wiggle Hop Stop can help your child release any extra energy they might have and practice calming techniques to move from high activity to low activity. Calm/Story Mode presents an engaging, quiet-time activity that can help a child work through difficult emotions and reach a place of quiet reflection.

GLOFRIENDS

To get the most out of the SEL features, use Wigglebug often with your child. Emotional development takes time and practice, which is exactly what Wigglebug is there to help with. Using the different modes frequently for fun and play will help your child know how to use Wigglebug when they really need to.



Access the control switches by opening the hook tape in bottom of Wigglebug.



WIGGLE HOP STOP MODE

At the start of the Wiggle, Hop, Stop! game, Wigglebug will say,

"Wiggle, Hop, Stop!"

Follow Wigglebug's instructions to move around and let out all your energy, then freeze! Wigglebug notices when your child follows the instructions and gives verbal praise for listening and following along.





At the start of calm Mode, Wigglebug will say,

"Let's be calm...

Listen to Wigglebug play soothing sounds and talk your child through imaginative stories.



FREE PLAY MODE

At the start of free Play Mode, Wigglebug will say,

"Let's play!"

In free Play Mode, there are lots of actions your child can do with Wigglebug! Try different things and see what Wigglebug says!

ACTIONS TO TRY:

- Hold Wigglebug upside down
- Rub Wigglebug's belly
- Hop like a bunny
- Fly Wigglebug through the air like an airplane
- Give Wigglebug a hug
- Spin Wigglebug



Use the switch on Wigglebug's battery pack to change Wigglebug from Play Mode to **Sleep Mode**.




When you switch Wigglebug into **Sleep Mode**, you will get to pick between several soothing sounds to accompany Wigglebug's glow. Press Wigglebug's foot to switch between beach, rain, outside, and lullaby sounds for one that your child enjoys listening to.

After 10 minutes in Sleep Mode, Wigglebug will automatically turn off to conserve batteries.













REPLACING THE BATTERIES

- Open the bottom to access the battery compartment.
- Remove the screw(s) with a small Phillip screwdriver.
- Open the lid and replace the 3 "AAA" batteries.
- Close the lid and insert the screw(s).

BATTERY SAFETY INFORMATION

- Adult supervision is recommended when inserting and removing batteries
- Do not use rechargeable batteries
- Do not mix old (used) and new batteries
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable batteries
- Do not attempt to recharge non-rechargeable batteries
- Batteries are to be inserted with the correct polarity (+ and -)
- Remove and properly dispose of exhausted batteries (recycle if possible)
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals
- Do not dispose of batteries in fire as they may explode or leak
